Theme: Disconnected in a Connected World

We live in a world that seems more connected than ever, through phones, social media, and technology. Yet, many people feel more alone, unheard, or unseen.

This theme invites you to explore this contrast.

Think about what it means to be connected, yet feel disconnected. Is it about people ignoring each other in real life? Is it about being lost in screens? Or is it about finding new ways to truly connect?

Create a meaningful piece of art that expresses your thoughts on this idea. Let your artwork reflect your interpretation while you experiment with different artistic techniques, styles, and mediums.

Registration Fees:

- For students in India: 150 INR
- For students in UAE: 15 AED
- For students in any other country: 10 USD

Instructions:

1. Each participant is allowed to submit ONLY one entry for Rang.
2. The artwork may be created using any medium and in any size (Digital artwork not accepted - Check 'Drishya' category).
3. Students must follow the given theme and create original artwork.

Submission Guidelines:

1. Submit a good resolution picture of the artwork as a JPEG/ JPG/ PNG file (300 DPI).
2. Maximum file size – 5MB, to be uploaded on the submission link, that will be received on your registered mail ID.
3. Label your artwork and name the image file with your name and category for clear identification. For example:
Nameofthestudent_CategoryName_Rang.jpeg

Criteria for Judgement:

The artwork will be judged based on the following criteria:

1. **Interpretation of the Theme:** How well does the artwork capture the essence of "Disconnected in a Connected World"? Does it present a unique and meaningful perspective on the theme?
2. **Artistic Skill and Technique:** Does the artwork demonstrate a strong command of artistic elements, skills and techniques.
3. **Creativity and Originality:** Does the artwork showcase innovative thinking and a fresh approach to the theme? Is it visually striking and unique?

Criteria for Judgement:

The artwork will be judged based on the following criteria:

4. **Conceptual Depth:** How effectively does the artwork convey a deeper meaning or message about the theme? Does it provoke thought and inspire discussion?

5. **Visual Impact:** Does the artwork have a strong visual presence? Does it engage the viewer and create an emotional response?
